ORDINANCE NO: 2024-32

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 91-13 FOR TAX YEAR 2025 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Electors of the Village Lakeview, Ohio, a majority of its elected members concurring:

SECTION I: To provide funds for the purposes of water, electric, and the general fund in the Village of Lakeview, the Village Council finds it necessary to amend Section XIV of Ordinance Number 91-13 for the 2025 tax year as follows:

SECTION XIV. Allocation of Funds

The funds collected under the provisions of this Ordinance during the 2025 tax year shall be applied for the following purposes and in the following order, to wit:

- 1) Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all costs and expenses of collecting the taxes levied by this Ordinance and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof.
- 2) That thirty-four percent (34%) of the remaining revenue, after the cost and expenses of collecting, administering and enforcing the taxes levied under this Ordinance, shall be used for water (Fund 5101) in the Village of Lakeview.
- 3) That thirty-three percent (33%) of the remaining revenue after the cost and expenses of collecting, administering and enforcing the taxes levied under this Ordinance, shall be used for electric (Fund 5301) in the Village of Lakeview.
- 4) That thirty-three percent (33%) of the remaining revenue after the cost and expenses of collecting, administering and enforcing the taxes levied under this Ordinance, shall be used for General Fund (Fund 1000) in the Village of Lakeview.

SECTION II: After the 2025 tax year, Section XIV of Ordinance Number 91-13 shall automatically and without further requirement of action revert to its original form as follows:

SECTION XIV. Allocation of Funds

The funds collected under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be applied for the following purposes and in the following order, to wit:

- 1) Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all costs and expenses of collecting the taxes levied by this Ordinance and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof.
- 2) That one hundred percent (100%) of the remaining revenue, after the cost and expenses of collecting, administering and enforcing the taxes levied under this Ordinance, shall be used for street construction, repair, maintenance and drainage in the Village of Lakeview.

SECTION III: Formal Actions

That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting and all deliberations of this Council or any of its Committees which led to such formal

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actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements

SECTION IV: Severability and Repealer.

If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law, or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION V: Notice

The Clerk shall cause a copy of this Ordinance be posted in a manner consistent with Ohio Law.


SECTION VI: Effective Date.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by Ohio Law.


SECTION VII: Declaring Emergency

This Ordinance is hereby found to be an emergency necessary for the public welfare, finances, and safety due to the continued increased cost of a municipal services, costs, the continued increased cost of recovery efforts in the Lakeview area due to the March EF3 tornado, to protect and provide for the Village finances, and to provide uninterrupted services within the Village which are necessary for the protection of the general public health, safety, and welfare. It shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage.
